At top right, illegible signature of controller in red colour pencil. Narrative: Donor is Elaine Kalman Naves, daughter of Gustav and Anikó Weinberger. The card is from Mrs. Fugys Ratzesdorf to Gustav Weinberger confirming that the Weinbergers arrived safely in Kisvárd. The correspondence was under supervision by a controller.
