Right side addressed to "Weinberger Gusztav / 108/101 m.sz. / Borgoprund / Beszterce-Naszod m." Sender's address at left "Dr. Békés Agnes / Debrecen, Simonffy u. / 32.". At top left, signature of Captain Soós in red colour pencil. Narrative: Donor is Elaine Kalman Naves, daughter of Gustav and Anikó Weinberger. The postcard was sent from the Békés family to Gustav Weinberger. Correspondence contains updates on the Weinberger, Békés and Ullmann families. The correspondence was under supervision of Captain Soós.
